three exclusive events to announce the 2022 edition

At the height of the pandemic in 2020, EURONAVAL was the only naval defence exhibition to be maintained in a fully digital format.

This year, with the return of exhibitors and visitors, EURONAVAL continues to evolve and develop its format. Three conferences dedicated to the geostrategic and technical issues of the naval sector will be held prior to the exhibition. Three events, organised in partnership with renowned think-tanks, on the three Mondays preceding the opening of the exhibition (3rd, 10th and 17th October). High-level French and foreign speakers will debate together and launch the 28th edition of EURONAVAL, the world's leading naval defence exhibition.

Monday 3rd October at 10am: Web conference “*War in Ukraine: strategic and tactical maritime insights*”, in partnership with the FMES (Mediterranean Foundation of Strategic Studies)

The round table led by the FMES Institute will bring together French, Italian, German and Korean researchers and experts. It will draw lessons on strategic and tactical levels of the Russian-Ukrainian naval war. Based on the characteristics of modern naval combat that are identified, it will determine the areas of action required to prepare for potential naval combat of tomorrow.

Monday 10th October at 10am: Web conference “*World naval rearmament*”, in partnership with the CESM (Centre for Strategic Studies of the French Navy)

In 2022, geopolitical uncertainties, power struggles and the growth of both conventional and hybrid threats, contribute to the need for major naval powers to invest in an efficient and accurate navy. Moreover, new technologies, from military and civilian industries as well, offer new opportunities for navies all over the world to develop their abilities to operate in every warfighting domain. To discuss the trend of naval rearmament, the French Navy Center for Strategic studies hosts a webinar on Oct. 10th with 3 major international experts.
